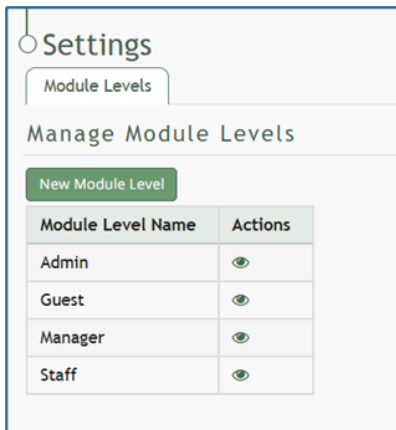



Add a New Module Level (Database Module)

To add a new module level in the Database Module, go to the Settings Page and select the “New Module Level” button.
